RE: **Update - Request for Proposal (RFP) No. P-12-91 – Award
Collection and Disposal of Waste and Recyclables at York Region Transit Facilities**

This memorandum provides a response to the question raised at Regional Council on January 24, 2013 regarding the destination of the waste and recyclables collected at York Region Transit facilities.

All waste and recyclables collected by GFL Environmental East Corporation, under RFP P-12-91, will be delivered to the Region's Waste Management Centre located at 100 Garfield Wright Boulevard in the Town of East Gwillimbury. This facility is the only approved material recovery and waste transfer station that can be utilized under RFP P-12-91. It is equipped for weighing and recording all waste and recyclables collected through this program.

Checks and balances have been put in place whereby staff are notified on a monthly basis of the number of loads that have been delivered to the facility under this contract. All vehicles used under this contract have been equipped with "Fleet Complete", a GPS-based system which tracks the vehicle's location at any point in time.

Accordingly, all expectations of Regional Council with respect to appropriate waste disposal procedures are being met through this contract with GFL Environmental East Corporation.
