COMMISSIONER OF TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNITY PLANNING**

1. Red Light Camera Enforcement Program

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December 17, 2012, recommending that:

1. Subject to approval of funds as part of the 2013 Budget process, the Commissioner of Transportation and Community Planning be authorized to execute agreements with the following, subject to the terms and conditions acceptable to the Commissioner of Transportation and Community Planning and subject to review of the Legal Services department to form and content;
 - a. A perpetual single source agreement with the Ministry of Transportation for Ontario (MTO) for the purposes of providing access to vehicle ownership information at an estimated cost of \$1,000 per year, per site, for an estimated total of \$20,000 annually;
 - b. A perpetual single source agreement with the City of Toronto for the purposes of processing infraction notices within the Red Light Camera Enforcement Program's Joint Processing Centre at an estimated cost of \$10,000 per year, per site for an estimated total of \$200,000 annually; and
 - c. A four-year sole source agreement with Traffipax, Inc. for the installation, operation and maintenance of red light camera equipment at a cost of \$2,500 per month, per site for an estimated total of \$600,000 annually.
2. The Regional Clerk circulate this report to York Regional Police and the Clerks of the local municipalities.

**2. Collection and Disposal of Waste and Recyclables
Request for Proposal P-12-91**

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December 7, 2012, recommending that:

1. Request for Proposal P-12-91 be awarded to GFL Environmental East Corporation for the collection and disposal of waste and recyclables at York Region Transit facilities for a period of five years commencing on March 3, 2013, in the amount of \$3,290,525.

3. Additional Construction Services for Donald Cousens Parkway Extension North of Major Mackenzie Drive, City of Markham **27**

December 12, 2012, recommending that:

1. Council authorize an increase in Blanket Purchase Order Number B00013156, issued to KAPP Contracting Inc., from \$1,736,655 to \$2,374,351.54, excluding taxes, for additional construction services related to the future extension of Donald Cousens Parkway (Y.R. 48) from Major Mackenzie Drive (Y.R. 25) to Highway 48.

4. Smart Commute Employer of the Year **35**

November 27, 2012, recommending that:

5. Traffic Control Signal Installations Various Locations **39**

December 18, 2012, recommending that:

1. A traffic control signal be installed at the intersection of Leslie Street (Y.R. 12) and Colonel Weyling Boulevard, on a temporary basis until Highway 404 is extended northerly and the school is relocated into the Sharon West Development, at which time staff will re-evaluate to determine permanent requirements, in the Town of East Gwillimbury.
2. A traffic control signal be installed at the intersection of The Queensway (Y.R. 12) and Joe Dales Drive/McMillan Drive, in the Town of Georgina.
3. A traffic control signal be installed at the intersection of Yonge Street (Y.R. 1) and Silver Maple Road, in the Town of Richmond Hill.
4. A traffic control signal be installed at the intersection of Islington Avenue (Y.R. 17) and Hayhoe Lane, in the City of Vaughan.
5. A traffic control signal be installed at the intersection of Rutherford Road (Y.R. 73) and Sherwood Park Drive, in the City of Vaughan.

6. A traffic control signal be installed at the intersection of Teston Road (Y.R. 49) and Cranston Park Avenue, in the City of Vaughan.
7. A traffic control signal be installed at the intersection of Teston Road (Y.R. 49) and Via Romano Boulevard, in the City of Vaughan.
8. Regional staff complete a comprehensive review of the current Traffic Signal Warrant Policy and report back for Council approval.
9. The Regional Clerk circulate a copy of this report to the Clerks of the local municipalities.
