Program for new entrepreneurs to run five Saturdays starting November 5th

PROGRAM GETS ENTREPRENEURS UP & RUNNING

NEWMARKET – The York Region Small Business Enterprise Centre has arranged a training program for entrepreneurs to be offered at York Region’s Administrative Centre at 17250 Yonge St. in Newmarket.

The Up & Running BizLaunch Program will be delivered over five Saturdays starting on November 5th. Participants will receive comprehensive small business skills training, a 200-page Small Biz Manual, a BizTOOLS CD and unlimited one-to-one coaching. The cost is \$495, including taxes.

The 30-hour program trains entrepreneurs in all key areas of small business. Delivered by experienced entrepreneurs, the program avoids textbook business theory and instead will focus on real-life small business practices, including ‘bootstrap’ marketing, how to write a sound business plan, costing and pricing for profit, avoiding legal pitfalls and understanding “love capital,” which is the money one can raise from family and friends to help start a business.
