Bathurst Collector/Langstaff Trunk Sewer Project Permit to Take Water Public Information Forum

The Regional Municipality of York completed a Class EA for the Bathurst Collector/Langstaff Trunk Sewer project in 2000. This Public Information Forum is being held to inform the public that the Permit to Take Water (PTTW) has been granted for this project and to allow interested persons the opportunity of discussing the PTTW with key personnel.

PRESENT:

- Representatives from the Regional Municipality of York
- Representatives from project consultant, Marshall Macklin Monaghan Ltd.

BACKGROUND:

- York Region plans to construct a 2700 mm diameter sewer along the north side of Langstaff Road and a 2700 mm diameter sewer along the west side of Bathurst Street to divert flows away from the Maple Relief Sewer to the York Durham Sewage System, as well as provide sanitary services for new development in the City of Vaughan.
- The project will be constructed using methods and equipment that do not require groundwater levels to be lowered during the construction program. However, the Region applied to the Ministry of the Environment for a Permit To Take Water as a contingency, should the tunnelling equipment encounter an obstruction that would require workers to clear the obstruction from outside of the tunnelling machine.
- Project location:
 - Bathurst Street (from Autumn Hill Boulevard south to Steeles Avenue).
 - Langstaff Road (from the West Don River east of Keele Street to Thornhill Woods Drive, then diagonally south east across
 - Highways 7 and 407 to Bathurst Street south of Highway 407)

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
