All TTC routes within York Region affected by service disruption

YRT/Viva remains operational

NEWMARKET – All 12 Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) contracted routes and their respective branches operating within York Region have been affected by the current TTC service disruption in the City of Toronto, effective this morning.

In order to assist residents affected by these disruptions, York Region is supplying extra shuttle buses from the Richmond Hill Centre Terminal (Yonge Street and Highway 7) to the Langstaff GO Station (north lot).

YRT/Viva is continuing to provide service to all regular destinations, including GO Finch Terminal, Don Mills, Downsview and Yorkdale stations (on street).

Individuals who rely on TTC services are encouraged to make alternate travel arrangements such as car pooling or the use of GO Transit services.
