BACKGROUND:

- York and Durham Regions are undertaking the Southeast Collector Trunk Sewer IEA to address the additional sanitary sewage requirements for future growth allowed in York Region's Official Plan
- York Region and Durham Region are co-proponents on the IEA as a portion of the study area is within Durham Region, and the Regions are co-owners of the existing primary components of the YDSS within Durham Region
- The preferred route has been identified as: Easement from 9th Line – 14th Avenue – Townline Road – Hydro Corridor – Liverpool Road – Finch Avenue East to Valley Farm Road
