Official opening of Teston Road reconstruction and Highway 400 interchange

NEWMARKET – The Regional Municipality of York and the Government of Ontario will host an official opening ceremony for the newly reconstructed Teston Road and newly constructed Highway 400 interchange in the City of Vaughan.

BACKGROUND:

- The Teston Road reconstruction and Highway 400 interchange construction is a \$28 million project constructed over the past two-and-a-half-years
- Construction entailed widening a portion of Teston Road to four lanes, widening a portion of Weston Road to five lanes, constructing a new bridge on Teston Road over Cold Creek and the construction of a new interchange at Teston Road and Highway 400
