## Watermain break forces lane reduction on Major Mackenzie Drive between Gram Street and Jackson Street in City of Vaughan

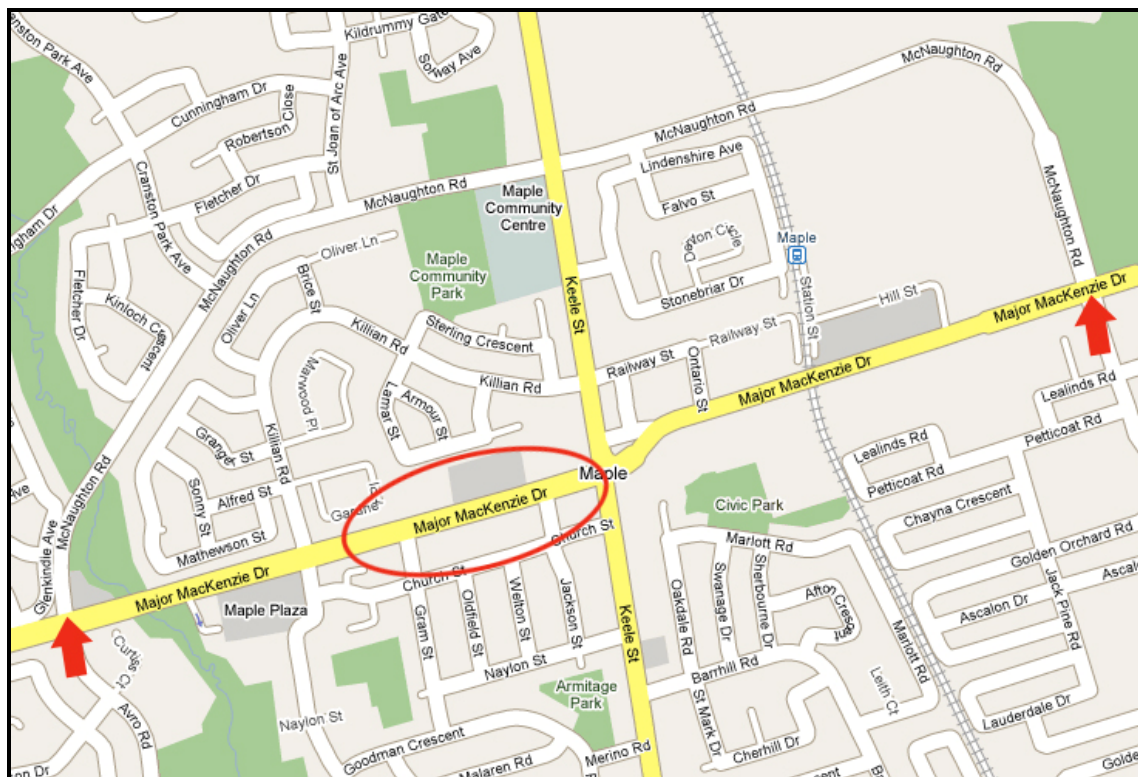
*Detour route established as watermain repairs will take several days to complete*

**NEWMARKET** – The Regional Municipality of York has closed two lanes on Major Mackenzie Drive between Gram Street and Jackson Street in the City of Vaughan due to a watermain break. Repairs will take several days to complete.

Traffic is still being maintained through the area, with one lane operating in each direction.

To help accommodate traffic during the morning and evening rush hours, staff from York Region and the City of Vaughan have established a detour route via McNaughton Road, around the affected area. Electronic signs have been placed to alert motorists to the lane reduction and detour. Alternatively, motorists can use Rutherford Road or Teston Road.

York Region thanks motorists for their patience as these emergency watermain repairs are completed.
