Aspiring lawyers compete at annual York Region Secondary School Mock Trial Competition

Students to argue a simulated case in front of a real judge, in an actual courtroom

NEWMARKET – The Regional Municipality of York is hosting the opening ceremonies of the annual York Region Secondary School Mock Trial Competition on Monday, February 23rd at 2 p.m. The event brings together more than 160 students, representing 21 schools from across York Region to compete for the coveted 2009 Judge's Cup.

Students prosecute and defend a criminal case through an interschool competition. Each team is aided by a lawyer coach leading up to and during the competition. Teams are evaluated on the basis of the following:

- Proper trial process and procedure
- Development and presentation of appropriate legal arguments and statements
- Oral advocacy and use of compelling arguments
- Witness performance and courtroom etiquette

Students also have the opportunity to speak one-on-one with recruiters and representatives, from The Regional Municipality of York, York Regional Police and Osgoode Hall Law School on potential career and education opportunities during a career fair before the competition opening ceremonies.

(The career fair takes place in the Great Hall beginning at 1 p.m.)
