Fee-waived Presto cards available at upcoming YRT/Viva region-wide events

Register a new PRESTO card at a YRT/Viva event and your \$6 set-up fee will be waived. If you already use PRESTO, stop by for customer support or to reload your card.

PRESTO cards distributed at YRT/Viva events are \$19 pre-loaded cards. A \$6 set-up fee will be waived for customers who purchase and register on-the-spot. Please note purchases are cash only.

PRESTO is the provincial electronic fare card system introduced across transit systems in the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA) in 2011. Simply tap your PRESTO card on a payment device and your fare is deducted. PRESTO eliminates the need for cash and tickets and makes it easy to transfer within and between participating transit systems.
