BY-LAW NO. 2008-28

A by-law respecting dedicated funds for
bicycle-related infrastructure

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario has committed funding through the Metrolinx BikeLinX Program to enhance the links between active transportation and public transit;

AND WHEREAS The Regional Municipality of York is eligible to receive such funding;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Regional Municipality of York (the “Region”) is hereby authorized to receive the sum of six hundred and ninety-three thousand, eight hundred and seventy-two dollars (\$693,872.00), (the “Funds”), from the Province of Ontario for bicycle-related infrastructure.
2. The Funds shall be placed in a dedicated, interest-bearing account until they are to be used.
3. The Funds shall be expended only on bicycle-related infrastructure, until the Funds are fully expended.

4. The Funds shall be used for the following:
 - (a) The sum of four hundred and eighty thousand dollars (\$480,000.00) shall be used to purchase and install bicycle racks on transit vehicles;
and
 - (b) The sum of two hundred and thirteen thousand eight hundred and seventy-two dollars (\$213,872.00) shall be used for secure and safe bicycle parking.
5. The expenditure of the Funds shall be in full compliance with any and all requirements, policies and procedures established by the Province of Ontario with respect to the Funds.
6. The Region shall submit a final summary report to Metrolinx detailing how the Funds were used, including the number of racks and storage spaces installed. Metrolinx may request an independent audit of the project.
