BYLAW NO. 2011-69

To remove part of Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) from the Regional Road System
in the Town of Markham

WHEREAS a small portion of Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) at its intersection with Ahorn Grove is no longer required for the widening of Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) but is required for the reconfiguration of Ahorn Grove; and

WHEREAS it is appropriate that the said lands be removed from the Regional road system; and

WHEREAS subsection 52(4) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (the “Act”) provides that an upper-tier municipality may remove a highway from its system; and

WHEREAS subsection 52(5) of the *Act* provides that if a highway is removed from an upper-tier highway system, it is under the jurisdiction of the lower-tier municipality in which the highway is located.

The Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the lands described in Schedule “A” be removed from the Regional road system and shall be under the jurisdiction of The Corporation of the Town of Markham.
2. Schedule “A” shall form part of this bylaw.
