BY-LAW NO. A-0367-2005-080

A by-law to designate by-law enforcement officers

WHEREAS subsection 1(1) of the *Provincial Offences Act* (the “Act”), provides that a provincial offences officer means a police officer or a person designated under subsection 1(3) of the Act;

AND WHEREAS a police officer does not include a special constable or a by-law enforcement officer;

AND WHEREAS subsection 1(3) of the Act provides that a Minister of the Crown may designate in writing any person or class of persons as a provincial offences officer for the purposes of all or any class of offences;

AND WHEREAS by communication dated July 30, 1984 the Solicitor General designated municipal by-law enforcement officers as Provincial Offences Officers;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of York
HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That any person employed by The Regional Municipality of York to enforce any Regional by-law is hereby designated a by-law enforcement officer.
2. That the designation of a person as a by-law enforcement officer shall cease immediately upon such person ceasing to be an employee of The Regional Municipality of York.
