BY-LAW NO. A-0383-2006-069

A by-law to appoint the
Commissioner of Transportation and Works
to designate parts of Regional roads as construction zones
and to set speed limits

WHEREAS subsection 128 (8.1) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.H.8 (the "Act") provides that a person appointed by a municipality may designate a highway or a portion of a highway under the municipality's jurisdiction as a construction zone;

AND WHEREAS subsection 128 (10) of the Act provides that the person authorized under subsection (8.1) may set a lower rate of speed for motor vehicles driven in the designated construction zone than is otherwise provided;

AND WHEREAS Regional Council wishes to make a designation under subsections 128 (8.1) and (10) of the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Commissioner of Transportation and Works for The Regional Municipality of York is hereby appointed to designate Regional roads or a portion of a Regional road as a construction zone and is authorized to set maximum rates of speed in such construction zones.

2. The General Manager, Roads, is hereby appointed to act on behalf of the Commissioner of Transportation and Works, as required, for the purposes of this by-law.
