RE: Director's Instruction for the transport of PCB wastes to Aevitas, Ayr, Ontario (and for greater than 50 litres of PCB liquid no later than April 9, 2012).

Location: 220 Doney Crescent, Concord
Owner: NOCO Lubricants Company
Generator # ON1476201
Waste: Approximately 36,024 litres of PCB containing waste material (primarily motor oil)

This letter constitutes Director's Instructions under Ontario Regulation 362 pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act.

As the owner or controller of a PCB waste as defined under Ontario Regulation 362; having PCB wastes; and having made arrangements with a PCB management and disposal company that is certified in Ontario, Aevitas Inc. (carrier# A821199) to transport PCB waste its facility in Ayr, Ontario (Certificate of Approval 1638-4YGL5B) for ultimate final incineration at the Swan Hills Treatment Centre, Alberta (Approval #1744-02-01).

These instructions hereby authorize you to remove these PCB wastes and release them to Aevitas Inc. (carrier# A821199) to transport PCB waste its facility in Ayr, Ontario (Certificate of Approval 1638-4YGL5B), as requested in your Recovery Services Product Contamination Incident Report (as amended) attached to your email of March 9, 2012.

This authorization to the owner is subject to the following conditions:

1. For PCB waste being removed from a registered PCB storage site, the total inventory of wastes stored shall be updated and copies submitted to the Toronto District Office of the Ministry of the Environment in accordance with Section 4(3) (a) (b) of Ontario Regulation 362.

2. All spills and leaks of PCB waste that occur from the storage and handling of PCBs while on your property, shall be reported forthwith to the Ministry's Spills Action Centre (1-800-268-6060) and to officials of the municipality in which they occur.
3. Every person engaged in the handling of PCBs or in charge of, managing or supervising such handling covered by this instruction shall be responsible for complying with each of these instructions.
4. Notification to Ministry of Environment's York Durham District Office a minimum of 24 hours prior to transportation. This notification should be received by the York Durham District Office within regular business hours and sent to the attention of Dave Fumerton, Director- Ontario Regulation 362.

The issuance of this letter in no way abrogates the owner's legal obligations to take all reasonable steps to avoid violating other applicable provisions of this legislation and any other legislation and regulations.
