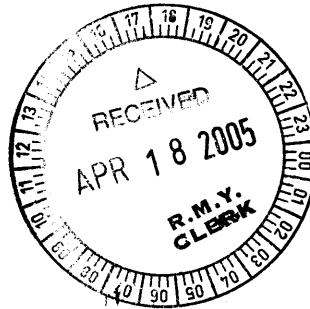

On behalf of the individuals receiving our support, we thank you for your consideration of this request.

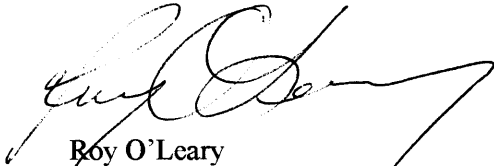
