2.	Notice of Public Meeting placed in newspapers and on the York.ca website.	March 10, 2007
3.	Draft Background Study and Proposed By-law Available to the Public	March 22, 2007
4.	Statutory Public Meeting	April 5, 2007
5.	Finance and Admin Committee review of by-law and background study pursuant to input received at the April 5 meeting.	May 3, 2007
6.	Council considers adoption of background study and passage of by-law. (Council also considers public input and if by-law is to be changed; formally determines whether a further public meeting is necessary.	May 17, 2007
7.	Newspaper notice of passage of by-law	By 20 days after passage
8.	Last day for by-law appeal	40 days after passage
9.	Availability of Development Charge Pamphlet, where by-law not appealed	By 60 days after passage
