1. The Amendment

At the end of the second paragraph of section 1.4, after the words "... on July 10, 2001" the quotation should be removed and placed at the end of the third paragraph after the words, "... the more restrictive policies apply."

2. General Policies

The last sentence in policy 2.16.6d) should be modified to read:

"In the event of a policy conflict, the Town of Markham may consult with the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing before adopting any amendments to this plan in determining the application of the more restrictive policies."

The first sentence in policy 2.16.6 h) should be modified to read:

"Municipal infrastructure, including stormwater management, transportation and servicing facilities are permitted, subject to the Rouge North Management Plan (2001), in Rouge Park North and Rouge North, ..."

The last sentence of section 2.16.6 l) should be modified to read:

"For any proposed updates to the Rouge North Management Plan (2001), the Region of York along with the Town of Markham may consult with the Province of Ontario regarding the proposed revisions as they relate to the Greenbelt Plan (2005) within the Town of Markham."

In section 2.16.6 j). insert a " ," between the words "URBAN RESIDENTIAL" and "AGRICULTURAL".

3. Middle Reaches Policy Area

In section 2.16.8 e)i), there is a typo that should be corrected to properly reference the Areas of Natural and Scientific Interest (ANSI). As such, please delete the word "National" and replace with the word "Natural".

In addition, MMAH recommends combining parts iv) and vii) to read as follows:

"Habitats or locations of federally, provincially, or locally rare, threatened, endangered species and species of concern, plant communities or wildlife species."

4. Little Rouge Creek Policy Area
In section 2.16.8 e)iii), the words “whichever is the more restrictive” should be added to the end of the sentence.
5. Oak Ridges Moraine
The last sentence of section 2.16.10 should be replaced with the following:

“The Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan Area forms part of the Greenbelt Plan Area. Although the lands within the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan Area are generally governed by the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan policies, section 3.3 of the Greenbelt Plan is also to be applied. Further, where, by the operation of subsection 2(4) of the ORMCP, lands are within the Oak Ridges Moraine Area but are not governed by the policies of the ORMCP, the lands are deemed to be within the Protected Countryside and all the policies of the Greenbelt Plan apply to the lands.”
