As someone with an interest in the conservation of the environmental health and quality of the Lake Simcoe watershed, you may be interested in knowing that the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority is reviewing its management plan for the **Holland Landing Conservation Area**.

Originally acquired in 1960, Holland Landing Conservation Area is Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority's oldest conservation area. Its acquisition and reforestation were among the first projects undertaken by the then Upper Holland Conservation Authority after it was established in 1951.

The Conservation Authority has begun a review of the existing management plan which will allow us to develop a vision to carry the property into the future. This plan review process will be a public one, with many opportunities for public review and input. The process will formally begin with a workshop on **Saturday March 26th 2011**.

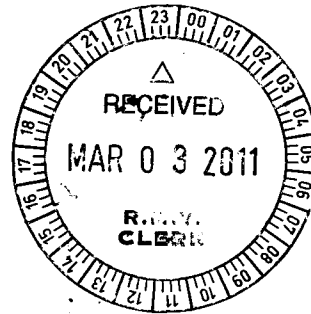
