RE: BILL 128 RE: MARIJUANA HOME GROWN OPERATIONS (C10-CL & L11)

Please be advised that the above-noted matter was placed before Council at its meeting held on November 1st, 2005.

It was the decision of the Council, at that time, to pass the following resolution:

"THAT MLEO (the Association of Municipal Law Enforcement Officers) OBOA (Ontario Building Officials Association, and OAPSO (the Ontario Association of Property Standards Officers) be requested to provide protocol training for by-law enforcement officers, building inspectors and fire inspectors prior to the passage of Bill 128;

AND THAT staff from the By-law Division of Clerks, Building Inspectors and Fire Inspectors be sent for training;

AND THAT the Clerk, in conjunction with the Director of Development Services and the Fire Chief be requested to prepare protocols for marijuana grow operation inspections;

AND THAT the Medical Officer of Health be advised that pursuant to Section 431.2 of the Municipal Act as amended by Bill 128, the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will be notifying the Medical Officer of Health of any marijuana grow operation found within the boundaries of the Town and will be seeking the Medical Officer of Health to send inspectors to carry out an inspection to the building regarding possible mould or other environmental contamination."
