Re: Upper York Sewage Solutions Project

Georgina Town Council was pleased, and would like to thank, York Region staff for hosting a public information meeting in Georgina on November 16th with regards the Upper York Sewage Solutions and its proposed discharge into Lake Simcoe.

Georgina Town Council recognizes that our community continues to harbour deep concerns regarding the project and the health of Lake Simcoe and the aquifer which together form our source of drinking and recreational water.

Georgina Town Council further recognizes that York Regional Council, having deferred a vote on the issue on October 20th, 2011, will be bringing the issue back before Council soon. Until that time, we respectfully request that York Region staff discontinue the use of "approved" and "preferred" in their public presentations and literature.

Our community continues to be confused with regard to the state of, or progress of, the environmental assessment schedule and we ask for more public information in that regard.

We request that both alternatives, ie discharge to Lake Ontario as originally proposed and discharge to Lake Simcoe as more recently recommended as the result of a Ministerial order, continue to be looked at as viable alternatives.
