My husband and I would hereby like to voice our objection to York Region's request for approval to increase Markham's population by 50% and to pave 7,3 square kilometres of farmland.

We would urge you to conduct further public consultation before approving this plan. Secondly, we would suggest that Markham's population growth be limited to less than 25% over the next 22 years. We would also encourage a 10-year moratorium be placed on urban expansion. Finally, we would love to see a permanent Markham foodbelt created from the Oak Ridges Moraine south to Major Mackenzie Drive!

We are subjected on a daily basis to an increase in traffic and pollution due to the construction just to the east of us. We abhor the destruction of prime farmland and would urge you to reign in your plans for continued and further out-of-control development.
