1. York Region Transit Charter Policy Update 1

January 23, 2004, recommending that:

1. The hourly rate for chartering York Region Transit buses be increased from \$80 to \$90 per hour for all conventional transit and Mobility Plus buses, effective March 1, 2004.
2. York Region Transit buses be made available to other Regional departments, local municipalities, and registered not-for-profit organizations at a discounted rate of \$60 per hour (increased from \$40), effective March 1, 2004.

2. York Region Transit Lost and Found Policy 9

January 23, 2004, recommending that:

1. The policy entitled 'Lost and Found' (*Attachment 1*) be adopted and that York Region Transit staff be authorized to communicate the policy to the local municipalities.
