At this meeting we need to establish an email address system for each community.

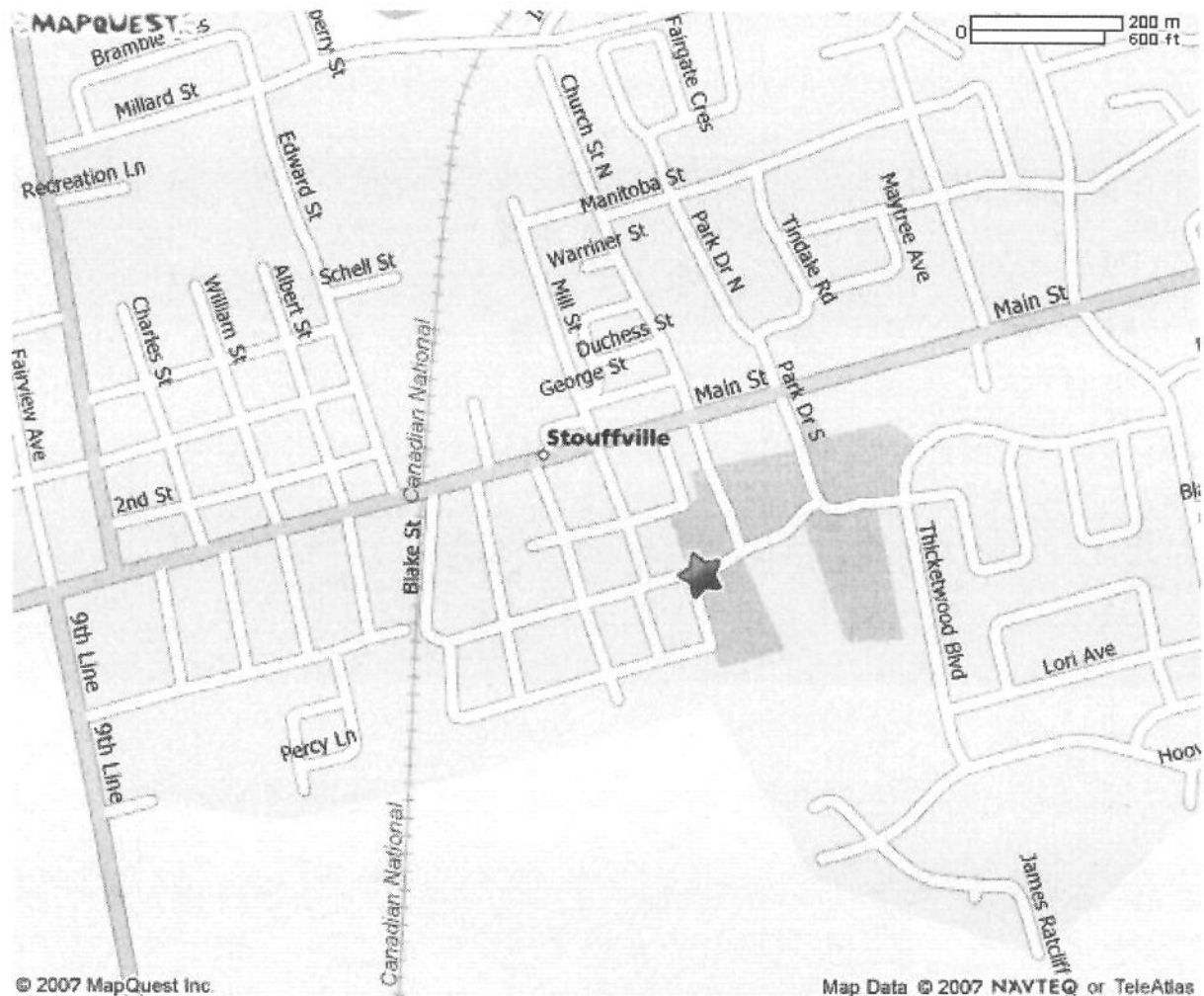
