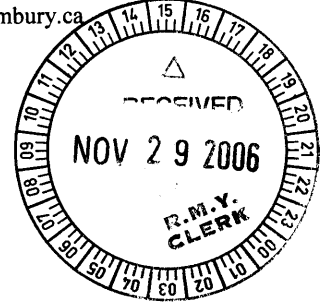

Re: York Durham (YDSS) Environmental Assessment for Municipal Sewage Services to Town of East Gwillimbury

For your information and records, at its regular meeting of Council on November 20, 2006, the Municipal Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury adopted the following resolution:

“WHEREAS the Minister of Environment on October 4, 2004 ordered that the York Durham (YDSS) Environmental Assessment (EA) for Municipal sewage servicing to the Town of East Gwillimbury be subject to an Addendum; and

WHEREAS the EA Addendum which has been subject to comprehensive public and agency review has identified in principle that the primary sewer route will be the Queensville Sideroad and the Second Concession; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Transportation has confirmed that bridge structures and north/south traffic construction capacity for the Highway 404 is scheduled to commence in 2007; and

WHEREAS the Queensville Sideroad/Highway 404 interchange and the Second Concession will be critical regional transportation requirements within the Town of East Gwillimbury and the Region of York; and

WHEREAS both Queensville Sideroad and Second Concession will need to be widened and urbanized in the near future to enable the development contemplated by the YDSS extension to proceed; and

WHEREAS construction of the sewer in the Queensville Sideroad and Second Concession road allowance and concurrent roads widening improvement and urbanization Queensville Sideroad and Second Concession will facilitate co-ordination of infrastructure improvements.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Subject to the YDSS Addendum being finalized and the primary route for the sewer being confirmed as the Queensville Sideroad and Second Concession.

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“Our town, Our future”

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THAT the Region include widening and urbanization of Queensville Sideroad (from Woodbine Avenue to Bathurst Street) and the Second Concession (from Queensville Sideroad to Green Lane) as priority projects in the Region's Ten Year Capital Programme; and

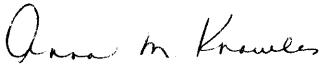
THAT the Environmental Assessment process for the road improvements be initiated immediately by the Region of York; and

THAT all funding initially for the Environmental Assessment process and for the road construction be secured through a Development Charge credit agreement with the East Gwillimbury Developers group; and

THAT all costs related to approval, widening and improvements of Queensville Sideroad and Second Concession be included in the Region's D.C. By-law update."
