**RE: Resolution -
On Street Parking during Off-Peak Hours**

At the Council Meeting of November 14th, 2011, Council of the Township of King passed the following Resolution:

“Whereas the Council of the Township of King is continuously attempting to identify key areas or initiatives to improve the economic viability of King’s community core areas;

Whereas Council of the Township of King are also continuously evaluating options to improve the safety of King’s community core areas related to pedestrian usage and traffic impacts;

Whereas Council of the Township of King have embarked on their Integrated Community Sustainability Plan, and recognize the significance and importance to residents and businesses of creating “walkable” communities and Main Street areas, where possible;

Whereas the Region of York has also identified within their Transportation Master Plan the strong connection between transportation and other critical elements, being: our communities, our natural environment and our economic well-being ;

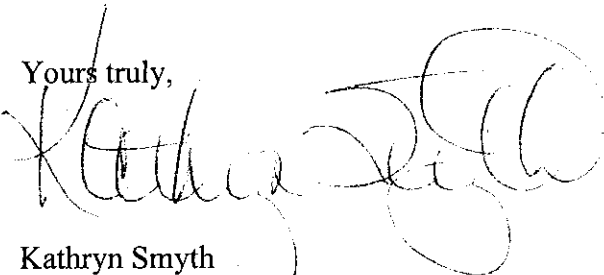
Whereas the Region of York has identified Transportation Sustainability Objectives, including, creating transit supportive land use form and design consisting of compact, mixed-use, pedestrian friendly communities, and to minimize single occupant vehicle trips;

Whereas it is these partnered objectives, principles and concepts that support the opportunity to enhance the community cores of Nobleton and King City by permitting on street parking near the key intersections and business areas of both communities;

Therefore the Council of the Township of King resolves as follows:

1. To respectfully request the York Region Transportation Services Committee to investigate and report upon options of permitting on street parking, during off-peak hours, at the following locations within King Township:
 - a. Nobleton – King Road (north and south side), east and west of Highway #27 (York Road 27); AND Highway #27 (east and west side), north and south of King Road
 - b. King City – King Road (north and south side), east of Keele Street through to Banner Lane”
