12. Vaughan's Highway 7 Corridor: Official Plan Amendment Nos. 660, 661, 662, 663 and 664

1. The Commissioner of Planning and Development Services be authorized to give notice to **approve** Amendment Nos. 663 and 664 to the Official Plan of the City of Vaughan Planning Area.

2. The Commissioner of Planning and Development Services be authorized to give notice to **approve** Amendment No. 662 to the Official Plan of the City of Vaughan Planning Area, and **modify** by replacing Schedules 'A' and 'B' with the Schedules contained in *Attachments 1 and 2*.
3. The Commissioner of Planning and Development Services be authorized to give notice to **approve** Amendment No. 660 to the Official Plan of the City of Vaughan Planning Area and **defer** the policy permitting residential land uses in the area identified in *Attachment 3*.

5. At the request of the City of Vaughan Council, the Ontario Municipal Board approve the proposed modification to the boundary of Amendment No. 661 to the Official Plan of the City of Vaughan Planning Area, as identified in *Attachment 5* and replace OPA 661 Schedules 'A' and 'B' and Figures 1 and 2 with *Attachments 6 to 9*.
6. Regional staff be authorized to appear at the Ontario Municipal Board in support of the Regional position.

13. Newmarket Official Plan Amendment and Subdivision Applications By Mademont Investments Inc.
