15. Consultant Selection for Engineering Services for the Detailed Design of Bathurst Street from Highway 7 to Teston Road City of Vaughan and Town of Richmond Hill (Request for Proposal P-11-01) **213**

June 1, 2011, recommending that:

1. Regional Council authorize staff to retain the consulting firm Delcan Corporation to undertake the detailed design for road improvements on Bathurst Street (Y.R. 38) from Highway 7 (Y.R. 7) to Teston Road (Y.R. 49), in the City of Vaughan and Town of Richmond Hill, at a cost not to exceed \$1,528,184 excluding HST.
2. The Commissioner of Transportation Services be authorized to execute the agreement, subject to terms and conditions acceptable to the Commissioner of Transportation Services and the Regional Solicitor's approval as to form and content.

16. Interim Improvements for Pedestrians on Rutherford Road Thomas Cook Avenue/Thornhill Woods Drive to Ilan Ramon Avenue, City of Vaughan **225**

June 3, 2011, recommending that:

1. Council authorize staff to partner with the City of Vaughan staff to implement interim improvements for pedestrians on Rutherford Road between Ilan Ramon Avenue and Thomas Cook Avenue / Thornhill Woods Drive; and
2. The Region's funding commitment for half of the \$400,000 estimated implementation costs be contingent on the City of Vaughan funding the other half of these costs and being solely responsible for the operation and maintenance of the interim pedestrian facilities.

17. Request for Proposal P-10-165 for Computerized Maintenance Management System **233**

June 6, 2011, recommending that:

1. Council approve the Region's entering into an Enterprise License Agreement with ESRI Canada for the acquisition, implementation and maintenance of Cityworks, a Computerized Maintenance Management System solution at a cost not to exceed \$1,366,428 excluding HST.

2. The Regional Chair and Clerk be authorized to execute the contract subject to the terms and conditions acceptable to the Commissioner of Transportation Services and subject to review of Legal Services to form and content.

**18. Scope of Work Change and
Increase in Total Project Budget Authority
Warden Avenue, 16th Avenue to Major Mackenzie Drive
Town of Markham**

June 2, 2011, recommending that:

1. Council approve the increased scope required for the reconstruction of Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) from 16th Avenue (Y.R. 73) to Major Mackenzie Drive (Y.R. 25), including increases in the span length of each of the three replacement bridges, unexpected soil conditions that have increased the complexity of the design and construction, increased environmental protection and impact mitigation, and increased traffic noise mitigation requirements.
2. Council authorize increasing the Total Project Budget Authority for the reconstruction of Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) from 16th Avenue (Y.R. 73) to Major Mackenzie Drive (Y.R. 25) from \$13,647,000 to \$25,250,000 for all project works, including design, utility relocation, and construction.
3. Council approve the additional design tasks for the reconstruction of Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) from 16th Avenue (Y.R. 73) to Major Mackenzie Drive (Y.R. 25) that arise from the changes in the scope of the project, at a cost of \$364,775, thereby increasing the assignment to McCormick Rankin Corporation from \$453,294.39 to \$818,069.39.
