RE: YORK REGION – INFLOW/INFILTRATION REDUCTION AND LONG TERM WATER CONSERVATION STRATEGIES (E00)

Please be advised that the above-noted matter was placed before Council at its meeting held on March 8, 2011.

It was the decision of the Council, at that time, to pass the following resolution:

- 1) THAT Council endorse the Region of York's Inflow and Infiltration Reduction Strategy subject to minor adjustments to the final drafts arising out of the Region's pre-submission consultation with the Ministry of the Environment and commit to:
 - a) Develop and maintain this strategy including programs, goals, interagency and regulatory reporting requirements for staged reduction of inflow and infiltration over the next 20 years; and,
 - b) Recommend to future Councils a commitment to funding for inflow and infiltration reduction programs; and,
 - c) Measure wastewater flows before and after carrying out construction/rehabilitation works on sewers and to document inflow and infiltration expenditures and flow reduction measures; and, d) Continue to work together in a collaborative manner over the life of the strategy and to commit the appropriate staffing and financial resources toward implementation of the strategy based on a business case analysis;
- 2) AND THAT Council endorse the Region of York's Long-Term Water Conservation Strategy.
