Please include these as comments to the above noted item.

We have read the recommendation on the GTA West corridor. It is our opinion that an interchange is needed at Kirby and the 400. With the urban boundary expansions slated to surround Hwy 400 up to Kirby Side Road, an interchange there would be best suited to accommodate those residents and businesses.

Secondly, Kirby side road between Bathurst and Dufferin needs to be opened as the only logical continuous east west corridor between Major Mackenzie and King. King Vaughan Line is not continuous as it jogs significantly south at Bathurst St. Teston also has its financial problems associated with the bridge crossing needed at Dufferin as well as the Keele Valley Dump site. Kirby is long overdue to be opened and as the sole property owners on both the north and south side of Kirby between Dufferin and Bathurst, we support its opening at this time.
