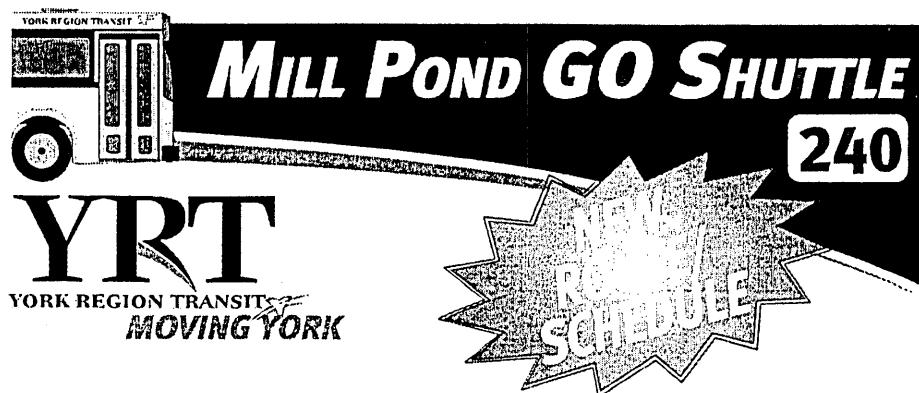
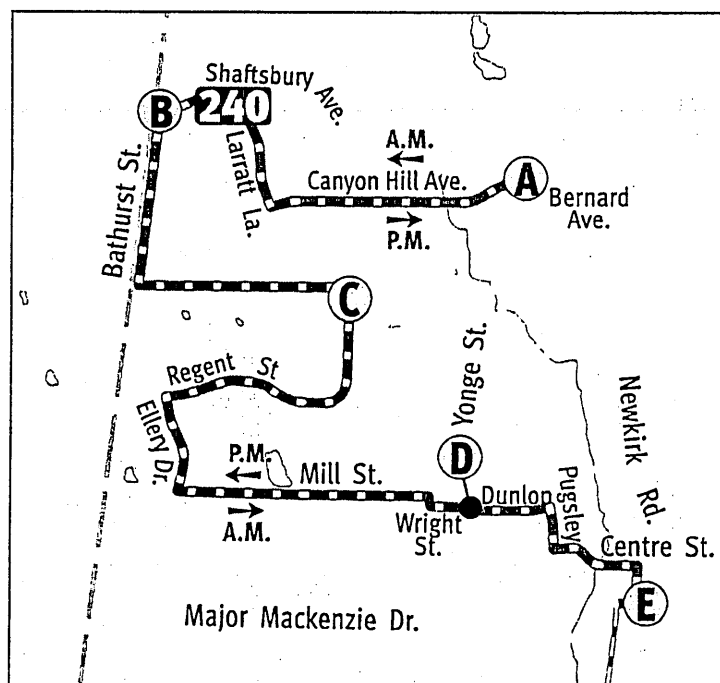

PETITION

TO YORK REGION TRANSIT, YORK REGION COUNCIL AND THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL MAYOR AND COUNCIL

We the residents of Ellery Drive, Ward Four in the Town of Richmond Hill and residents of lots adjoining Ellery Drive, draw the attention of the York Region Transit, York Region Council and the Mayor and Council of the Town of Richmond Hill to the following:

That as of May 9th, 2004 a new GO Shuttle Bus Route, "Mill Pond GO Shuttle Route 240" has been routed onto Ellery Drive, Ward Four in the Town of Richmond Hill. Ellery Drive, is parallel to Bathurst Street and is only one-half kilometre in length (0.5 km.), it intersects with Mill Street at its most southern point and Regent Street at its most northern point. Ellery Drive is an avenue with center islands planted with trees and shrubs. It is part of a very beautiful, quiet neighbourhood. When Heritage Estates was being built, (the original purchasers of lots on Ellery Drive, were assured by the builders and the Town of Richmond Hill, that there would be absolutely no bus routes other than yellow school buses, on Ellery Drive), purchasers were informed of existing public transit along Mill Street and planned public transit along Regent Street.

Therefore, we the undersigned, your petitioners respectfully request that all public transit, (except for the "yellow school bus runs" and the presently existing 3 morning and 3 afternoon "York Region Transit school bus runs"), and the new GO Shuttle Bus Route 240 be re-routed so that they do not run along Ellery Drive, for the following reasons:

- INCREASED LEVELS OF AIR POLLUTION
- INCREASED RISK TO RESIDENTS' HEALTH
- NOISE POLLUTION
- ENDANGERMENT OF NEIGHBOURHOOD CHILDREN
- DEPRECIATION OF PROPERTY VALUES
- BREACH OF AGREEMENT

By re-routing the GO Bus Shuttle 240 run from Ellery Dr. to Bathurst St., the impact to the public transit riders will be minimal, estimated to be an additional maximum of a 2 minute stroll, at a leisurely pace. The impact to the YRT GO Shuttle System will be insignificant, since the target of delivering passengers to the Richmond Hill GO station will remain within the 15 minute targeted (by YRT GO) delivery schedule.

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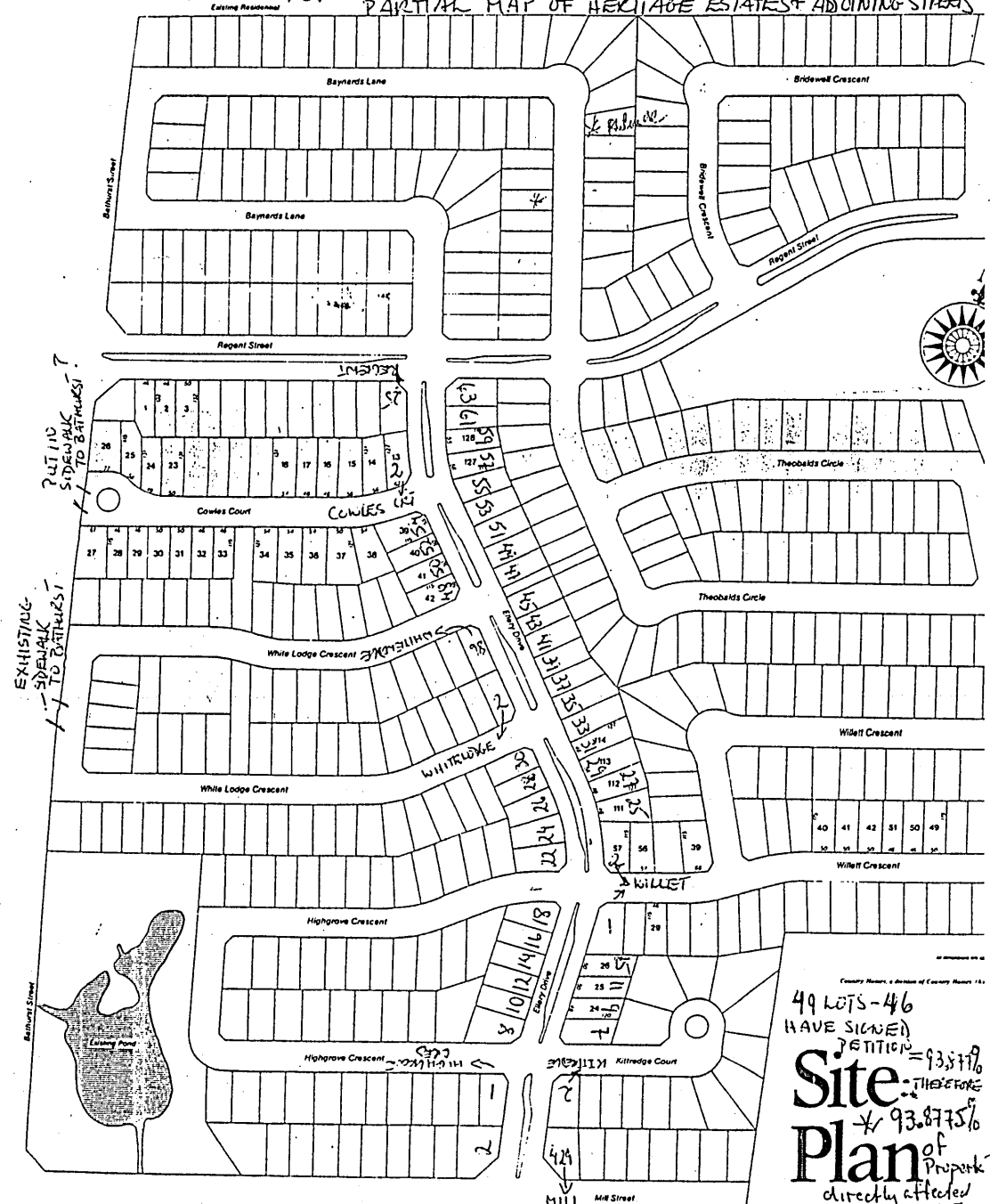
