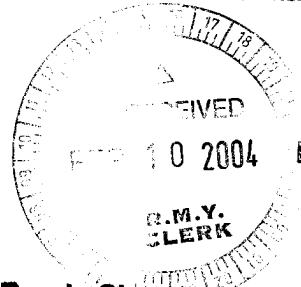

MUNICIPAL COUNCIL PRESENTATION

We are asking for Council to approve the diversion of used asphalt roof shingles, collected in their Municipality, from being landfilled, and to instead be stockpiled for recycling, at a location within the Municipality.

We are asking Council to instruct their Road Engineering Department, to investigate and substantiate that the ground shingles are a benefit to your Municipality as an additive to hot mix asphalt paving used for road construction, and as an additive to your the existing Municipal gravel roads and parking lots as a dust suppressant, and also as a binder, to assist any existing gravel surface, to become a more firm and durable driving surface.

If your Municipality does not have a shingle stockpiling location, Council can still approve the recycling of shingles, rather than landfilling them.

In that situation, CWR can make arrangements with your Municipality (or you can make arrangements on your own) to truck the shingles from the Municipality, to a CWR location for recycling.

CWR would still need your Municipal Engineering Dept. approval for the use of the ground shingles as an approved additive, so that the recycled shingles can be used back into your Municipality.

It is important that the shingles collected in your area, are recycled and reused to benefit the roads in your area.
