

Resolution – November 29-04  
Taxi – Transportation Alternatives

Whereas the continued growth in the population of York Region necessitates the promotion of all forms of transportation which constitute alternatives to automobiles with only one passenger---the driver, and

Whereas taxi cabs represent one such alternative, providing as they do necessary occasional transportation to individuals who might otherwise require, for their sole use, yet another automobile in York Region, and

Whereas the promotion of the use of taxis can be enhanced by their availability at key intersections of regional roads,

Now therefore, the Council of the Regional Municipality of York directs staff to identify locations for the establishment of taxi stands in the vicinity of major intersections, particularly immediately north of Steeles Avenue, where York Region Transit service may not be available to users of Toronto Transit Commission vehicles wishing to travel north into York Region.
