EXTRACT FROM COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES APRIL 11, 2005

98. ASIAN LONG-HORNED BEETLE YARD WASTE PROCESSING SITE
(Addendum No. 1)

MOVED by Councillor Yeung Racco
seconded by Councillor Di Vona

That the Regional Municipality of York be advised that the City does not support the processing of yard waste materials from within the Regulated area at the Region's South-West Patrol Yard on Rutherford Road;

That, in order to ensure that the residents of Vaughan continue to receive yard waste collection services, the City permit the Region of York to process yard waste material collected from within the Regulated area at its Dufferin Street Works yard on a temporary basis, until such time as the Region establishes another facility for this purpose within the Regulated area;

That City of Vaughan staff work with the Region to ensure that that the grinding of the materials delivered to the Dufferin Street location is done at such time and such frequency to ensure the least possible disruption;

That the City permit the Region to use the Dufferin Street facility at no cost;

That should the Region decide not to take any further action with respect to creating a processing facility at the City's Ashbridge Circle location, the Region seek out private lands within the Regulated area to create such a processing facility;

That the City of Vaughan advise the Ministry of the Environment, that as owners of the property known as No. 8000 Dufferin Street, where the processing of yard waste collected from within the Regulated area will take place, that the City has no objections to the temporary use of this property for this purpose;

That staff track all costs related to the Asian Long-Horned Beetle initiative; and

That the confidential report of the Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works, dated April 11, 2005, be received.
