1. Community Safety Zones in School Areas 1

May 2, 2012, recommending that:

1. The Community Safety Zone policy be revised to designate:
 - i) All School Zones as Community Safety Zones, as per *Attachment 1*.
 - ii) All School Areas as Community Safety Zones, as per *Attachment 2*.
 - iii) All road sections around small schools (less than 200 students) as Community Safety Zones, as per *Attachment 3*.
2. The Regional Solicitor prepare the necessary bylaws.
3. The Regional Clerk circulate this report to the Clerks of the local municipalities and to the Chief of York Regional Police.

2. Deferral of Proposed CN Rail Grade Separation on 19th Avenue, Bayview Avenue, Elgin Mills Road to Stouffville Road, 19th Avenue, Linda Margaret Crescent to Bayview Avenue, Town of Richmond Hill 21

April 18, 2012, recommending that:

1. The Regional Clerk circulate this report to the Clerk of the Town of Richmond Hill and GO Transit for information.

3. Highway 404 Mid-Block Crossings Study in Markham and Richmond Hill 29

April 20, 2012, recommending that:

1. Council support the planning, protection and construction of the following key infrastructure along the Highway 404 corridor, consistent with the Regional Official Plan and Transportation Master Plan, to improve the transportation network connectivity and accessibility, traffic and transit operations, and economic development opportunities:

- a. Mid-block collector road crossings over Highway 404 between: Highway 7 and 16th Avenue; 16th Avenue and Major Mackenzie Drive; Major Mackenzie Drive and Elgin Mills Road; and, Elgin Mills Road and 19th Avenue.
 - b. A full interchange at Highway 404 and 19th Avenue.
 2. For the three mid-block collector road crossings of Highway 404, north of 16th Avenue, York Region:
 - a. Take the lead in conducting the environmental assessments.
 - b. Maintain its current one-third share of the capital cost.
 - c. Fund one-third of the long-term replacement costs of the crossings.
 3. Council authorize staff to develop an implementation plan with the Towns of Markham and Richmond Hill and to report back on progress by year end.
 4. The Regional Clerk circulate a copy of this report to the Minister of Transportation of Ontario, and the Clerks of the Town of Markham and Town of Richmond Hill.
