WHEREAS the Thunder Bay District Health Unit has requested support from its member municipalities on its concerns in regards to the link between trans fat and coronary heart disease and, to some extent, diabetes and obesity;

AND WHEREAS Council supports the Thunder Bay Health Unit in its efforts to preserve good health of the citizens;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Municipality of Shuniah hereby supports the Thunder Bay District Health Unit's Resolution No. 07-24 endorsing the Trans Fat Task Force Report: Transforming the Food Supply; June 2006 and further in urging the federal Minister of Health to move forward from the regulated labeling of trans fat on prepackaged foods and to act on the recommendations from the "Trans Fat Task Force Report: TRANSforming the Food Supply", June 2006;
