The applicant requests permission to clear approximately 7 acres of land, plus a 30-foot pathway on the south of the property, to convert same into farming.

**6. HEARING – APPLICATION FOR EXCEPTION
GERALD DRAPER – TOWN OF GEORGINA
REGIONAL TREE BY-LAW NO. TR-1-91-154**

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IN THE MATTER OF the Trees Act R.S.O. 1990, Section 9, c.T.20 (the “Act”),

AND IN THE MATTER OF By-law No. TR-1-91-154 of The Regional Municipality of York (the “By-law”),

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application for a minor exception to the By-law by Gerald Draper, Part Lot 10, Concession 7, Town of Georgina, Ontario.

The applicant requests permission to clear approximately 10 acres of land to convert same into farming.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Regional Council is proposing to pass by-laws authorizing the works set out below.

Pursuant to Section 300 of the *Municipal Act*, the Transportation and Works Committee of the Regional Council will hear any person who claims that his/her lands will be prejudicially affected by the by-laws and who applies to be heard. If any party entitled to be heard does not attend at the hearings, the Committee may proceed in his/her absence and he/she will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceedings.

7. INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS TO QUEENSVILLE SIDEROAD (Y.R. 77) AND SECOND CONCESSION ROAD, TOWN OF EAST GWILLIMBURY, PROJECT 9066 13

THE COUNCIL OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK
PROPOSES TO PASS A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING:

- a) The reconstruction of the turning lanes in the intersection of Queensville Sideroad (Y.R. 77) and Second Concession Road in the Town of East Gwillimbury;
- b) The provisions for future signals and adjustments to associated illumination at the reconstructed intersection of Queensville Sideroad (Y.R. 77) and Second Concession Road;
- c) The carrying out of all related works and undertakings in connection with the above; and 34) and Brooker Ridge/Laurelwood Gate.
- d) The acquisition of the necessary lands and interest in lands for the works described above.

8. INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS TO AURORA ROAD (Y.R. 15) AND WARDEN AVENUE (Y.R. 65), TOWN OF WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE, PROJECT 9416 19

- a) The construction of the turning lanes in the intersection of Aurora Road (Y.R. 15) and Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville;
- b) The provision of new traffic signals and associated illumination at the reconstructed intersection of Aurora Road (Y.R. 15) and Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65);
- c) The carrying out of all related works and undertakings in connection with the above; and
- d) The acquisition of the necessary lands and interest in lands for the works described above.

9. WIDENING AND RECONSTRUCTION OF ISLINGTON AVENUE FROM RUTHERFORD ROAD TO MAJOR MACKENZIE DRIVE WEST – CITY OF VAUGHAN, PROJECT 9859 25

- a) The widening and reconstruction of Islington Avenue (Y.R. 17), from approximately 450 metres north of Highway 7 (Y.R. 7) to approximately 500 metres north of Rutherford Road (Y.R. 73) in the City of Vaughan, to a basic width up to:

- i) 36.0 metres from approximately 450 metres north of Highway 7 (Y.R. 7) to Woodbridge Avenue with additional widenings at cuts, fills and intersections, to provide a basic four lane road with left and right turning lanes at Woodbridge Avenue.
 - ii) 3.0 metres from Woodbridge Avenue to Willis Road/Davidson Drive with additional widenings at cuts, fills and intersections, to provide a basic four lane road with left and right turning lanes at key intersections.
 - iii) 20.0 metres from Willis Road/Davidson Drive to Langstaff Road (Y.R. 72) with additional widenings at cuts, fills and intersections, to provide a basic two lane road with a continuous centre left turn lane.
 - iv) 36.0 metres from Langstaff Road (Y.R. 72) to 500 metres north of Rutherford Road (Y.R. 73) with additional widenings at cuts, fills and intersections, to provide a basic four lane road with left and right turning lanes at key intersections.
- b) The adjustments to existing traffic control signals to accommodate the proposed roadworks at the intersections of Islington Avenue (Y.R. 17) with Woodbridge Avenue, Willis Road/Davidson Drive, Langstaff Road (Y.R. 72), Wycliffe Gate and Rutherford Road (Y.R. 73);
- c) The carrying out of all related works and undertakings in connection with the above; and
- d) The acquisition of the necessary lands and interests in lands for the works discussed above.

10. WIDENING AND RECONSTRUCTION OF WOODBINE AVENUE (Y.R. 8) FROM RAVENSHOE ROAD (Y.R. 32) TO OLD HOMESTEAD ROAD (Y.R. 79), TOWN OF GEORGINA, PROJECT 9670 33

- a) The widening and reconstruction of Woodbine Avenue (Y.R. 8) from Ravenshoe Road (Y.R. 32) to Old Homestead Road (Y.R. 79) in the Town of Georgina to a basic width up to 36.0 metres. Additional widening will be required at cuts, fills, watercourse crossings and intersections, to provide a basic four lane road with continuous left-turn and right-turn lanes at the intersections;
- b) The adjustments to existing traffic control signals and associated illumination to accommodate the proposed revisions to the road layout at the intersections of Woodbine Avenue (Y.R. 8) and Ravenshoe Road (Y.R. 32), Glenwoods Avenue West, Biscayne Boulevard, Morton Avenue (Y.R. 78) and Old Homestead Road (Y.R. 79);

- c) The provision of new signals and associated illumination at the intersections of Woodbine Avenue with Riverglen Drive and Church Street;
- d) The provision for future traffic control signals and associated illumination at the intersections of Woodbine Avenue (Y.R. 8) with Glenwoods Avenue East, Riveredge Drive, Arlington Drive, Wexford Drive and Dunville Road;
- e) The widening of Maskinonge Bridge which conveys Maskinonge River under Woodbine Avenue (Y.R. 8) south of Morton Avenue (Y.R. 78);
- f) The carrying out of all related works and undertakings in connection with the above; and
- g) The acquisition of the necessary lands and interest in lands for the works described above.
