



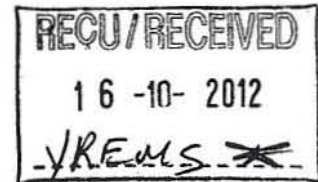

Dear Sir/Madame:

For your information and records, at its regular meeting held on October 1, 2012, the Municipal Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacted as follows:

WHEREAS centralized 911 dispatch services has been an issue for many years in York Region; and

WHEREAS York Regional Council had requested the Province in 2005 to make legislative changes necessary to allow the region to proceed with a joint communication service; and

WHEREAS agreements between York Regional Police and local municipal fire services to share radio infrastructure have occurred since 2005; and

WHEREAS significant system efficiencies can be realized as demonstrated by Niagara Region's communication dispatch centre;

BE RESOLVED THAT that the Municipal Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury request that the Regional Municipality of York petition the Province of Ontario in order to establish a consolidated dispatch for all emergency service in the Region of York; and

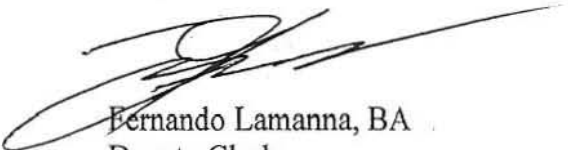
