As someone with an interest in the conservation of the environmental health and quality of the Lake Simcoe watershed, you may be interested in knowing that the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority is reviewing its management plan for **Rogers Reservoir Conservation Area**.

Rogers Reservoir Conservation Area is 68 hectares along the banks of the East Holland River in the Town of East Gwillimbury. This conservation area supports a mix of forest, wetland and grassland habitat, as well as over 6 km of recreational trail, including part of the inter-municipal Nokiidaa trail network.

The Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority has begun a review of the existing management plan which will allow us to develop a vision to carry the property into the future. This is a public plan review process, with many opportunities for public review and input. The public process will formally begin with a workshop on **Saturday October 15th 2011**.

This workshop will be preceded by a **BBQ** hosted by the Holland Landing Lions Club, and **guided hikes** of Rogers Reservoir Conservation Area hosted by the East Gwillimbury Trails Committee between **noon** and **1:30 pm**.
