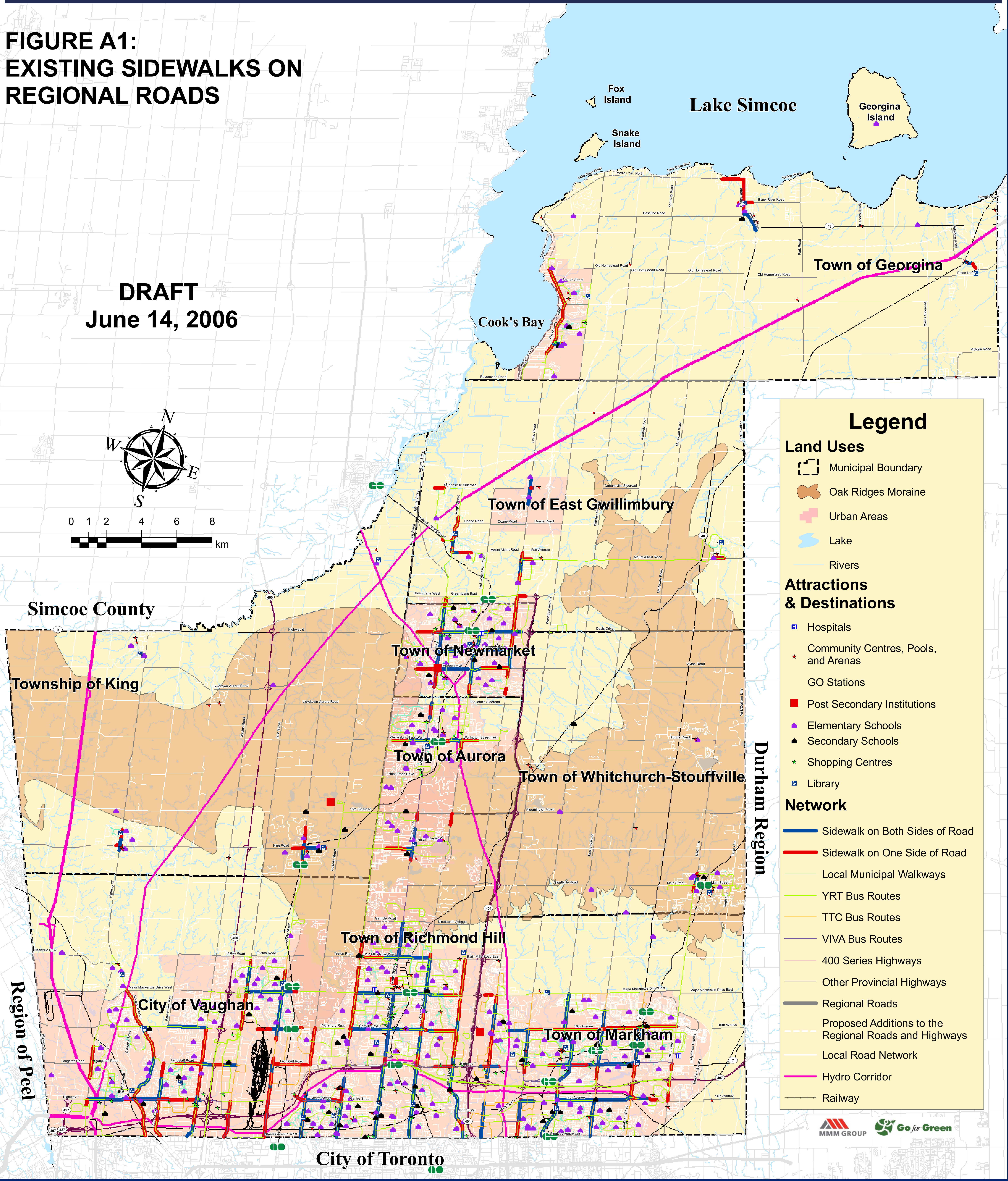


**FIGURE A1:

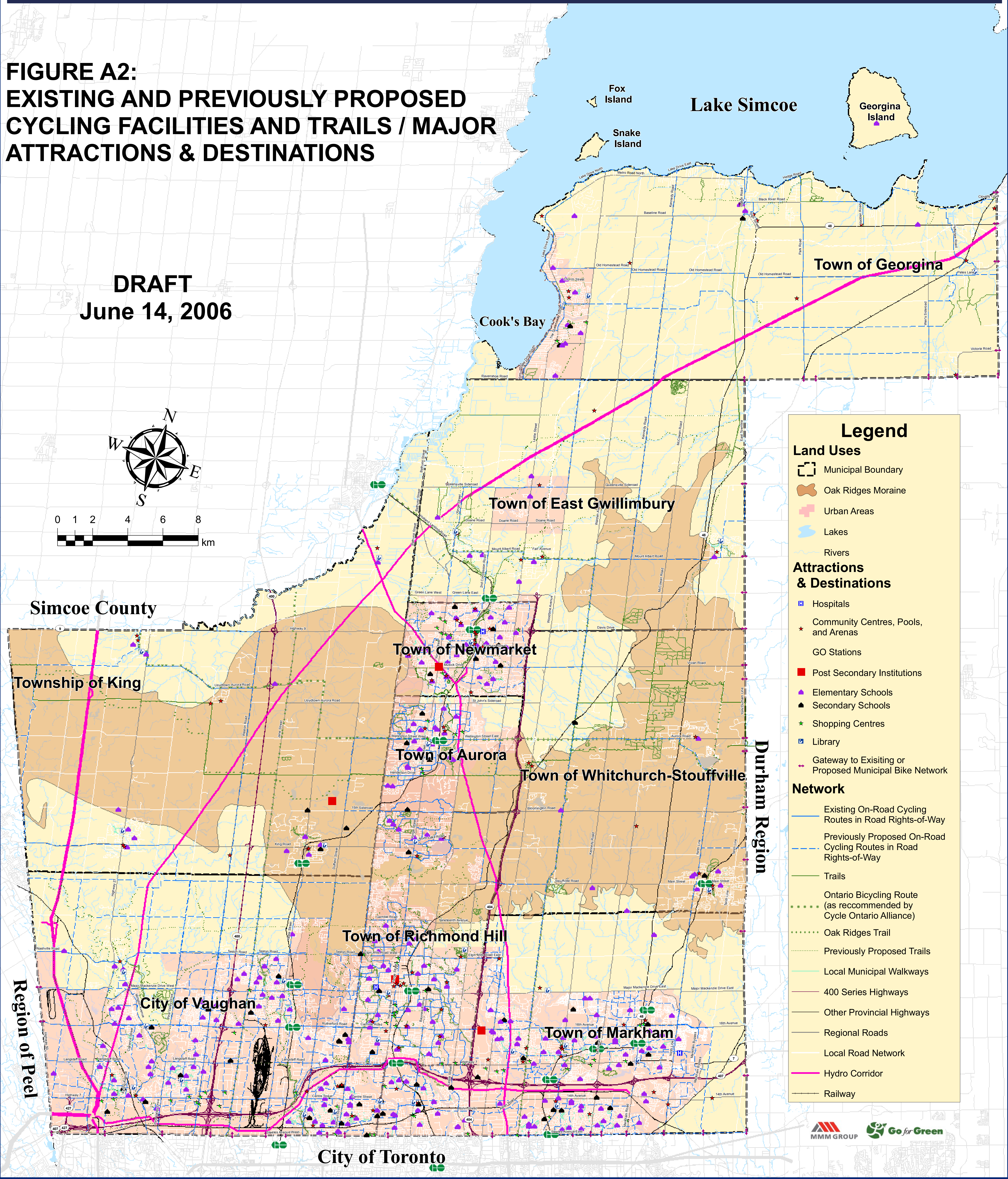


**FIGURE A2:
