For your information and records, at its regular meeting held on October 1, the Municipal Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacted as follows:

WHEREAS Council at its meeting December 19, 2011 passed resolution CWC 2011-60 requesting the Region approve intersection improvements and signalization at the intersection of Colonel Wayling Boulevard and Leslie Street adjacent to the Sharon West development area in advance of signal warrants being met, and

WHEREAS the Region has responded that the intersection at Colonel Wayling Boulevard and Leslie Street will not be considered for signalization at this time but will be monitored after full build out to verify warrants for signalization, and

WHEREAS Council believes that the current traffic volumes and delays to southbound turning movements from the existing residential area, in addition to the proximity to Sharon Public School and additional construction traffic, will continue to negatively impact this intersection, therefore

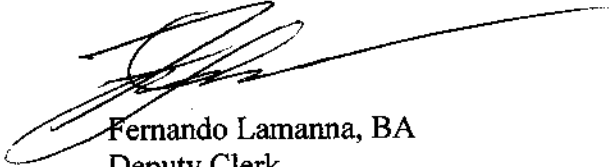
BE IT RESOLVED THAT, in light of community safety concerns, Council request that the Region reconsider their current position for the installation of traffic signals at the intersection of Colonel Wayling Boulevard and Leslie Street in advance of the warrants being met, as this is a community safety zone.
