BY-LAW NO. R-1391-2004-031

To authorize the Commissioner of Transportation and Works
to temporarily close certain Regional roads

WHEREAS certain Regional roads shall be closed temporarily to through traffic
to accommodate construction projects;

AND WHEREAS section 42 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a council
may delegate to an employee the power to close a highway temporarily for any purpose
specified in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York
HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The Commissioner of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to exercise
all of the powers of Council with respect to the temporary closing of the
following Regional roads for such time as is required during construction
between the dates indicated:
 - (a) Langstaff Road (Y.R. 72) from Islington Avenue (Y.R. 17) to Pine
Valley Drive (Y.R. 57) in the City of Vaughan for a duration of
approximately one week between May 15, 2004 and August 31, 2004;
 - (b) St. John's Sideroad (Y.R. 26) from Yonge Street (Y.R. 1) to Industrial
Parkway North in the Town of Aurora for a duration of approximately
five months between May 3, 2004 and October 28, 2005;

- (c) St. John's Sideroad (Y.R. 26) from Bayview Avenue (Y.R. 34) to Leslie Street (Y.R. 12) in the Town of Aurora for a duration of approximately four months between December 6, 2004 and August 31, 2005;
- (d) Gamble Road (Y.R. 29) from Bathurst Street to Yonge Street (Y.R. 1) in the Town of Richmond Hill for a duration of approximately four months between July 5, 2004 and October 29, 2004;
- (e) Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25) from Highway 48 (Y.R. 68) to Ninth Line (Y.R. 69) in the Town of Markham for a duration of approximately two days between June 12, 2004 and August 27, 2004;
- (f) Old Homestead Road (Y.R. 79) at the crossing of the Maskinonge River tributary, commencing 1350m east of Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) in the Town of Georgina for a duration of approximately three days between May 3, 2004 and September 30, 2004;
- (g) Green Lane (Y.R. 19) at the GO Level Crossing, east of the 2nd Concession, in the Town of East Gwillimbury for a duration of approximately three days between May 8, 2004 and September 25, 2004;
and
- (h) Mulock Drive (Y.R. 74) at the GO Level Crossing, east of Yonge Street in the Town of Newmarket for a duration of approximately three days between May 8, 2004 and September 25, 2004.
