BY-LAW NO. R-1417-2005-030

To abandon certain lands acquired for or in connection with the widening and reconstruction of Warden Avenue (YR 65) from Steeles Avenue to 16th Avenue (YR 73), in the Town of Markham

WHEREAS the Council of The Regional Municipality of York by its By-law No. R-1288-2002-052 enacted and passed on June 27, 2002, and by a Plan of Expropriation registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of York Region as No. D849 expropriated certain lands for or in connection with the widening and reconstruction of Warden Avenue (YR 65) from Steeles Avenue to 16th Avenue (YR 73), in the Town of Markham;

AND WHEREAS part of the expropriated lands have been found to be unnecessary for the purposes of the Regional Corporation;

AND WHEREAS a Notice of Abandonment of Land of such part of the lands has been served upon the registered owners thereof pursuant to the provisions of the *Expropriations Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter E.26;

AND WHEREAS all of the owners have elected to take such part of the lands back;

Now, therefore, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The Regional Municipality of York hereby abandons the lands described as follows:

Lands in the Town of Markham in The Regional Municipality of York, being part of Lot 6, Concession 4, designated as Parts 4 and 5 on a plan of expropriation registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of York Region on the 9th day of September, 2002 as No. D849.

2. (1) The Regional Chair and Regional Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign a Declaration of Abandonment of the lands described in section 1 and the Regional Clerk is authorized and directed to affix the seal of the Regional Corporation thereto.

(2) When so signed and sealed, the Regional Commissioner of Corporate Services is directed to cause the said Declaration of Abandonment to be registered in the proper Land Registry Office and to pay all expenses incidental to the registration, and to cause the said Declaration of Abandonment to be served on the registered owners of the lands described in section 1.
