BY-LAW NO. R-1444-2006-046

To authorize the Commissioner of Transportation and Works
to temporarily close of part of Davis Drive (Y.R. 31)
in the Town of Newmarket

WHEREAS to facilitate construction activities for the purpose of constructing a pedestrian bridge, a certain section of Davis Drive between Prospect Street (Y.R. 34) and Patterson Street/Roxborough Road, in the Town of Newmarket, shall be closed temporarily to through traffic;

AND WHEREAS section 42 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a council may delegate to an employee the power to close a highway temporarily for any purpose specified in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Commissioner of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to exercise all of the powers of Council with respect to the temporary closing of Davis Drive (Y.R. 31) from Prospect Street to Patterson Street/Roxborough Road, in the Town of Newmarket, to allow the construction of a pedestrian bridge. The dates for the road closure shall be the times listed below or as otherwise required during construction:
 - (a) from 12:01 a.m. Saturday, July 8, 2006 to 5:00 a.m. Monday, July 10, 2006;
 - (b) from 12:01 a.m. Saturday, July 15, 2006 to 5:00 a.m. Monday, July 17, 2006; and if required

- (c) from 12:01 a.m. Saturday, July 22, 2006 to 5:00 a.m. Monday, July 24, 2006.
