BY-LAW NO. R-1447-2006-070

Respecting temporary speed limits on Regional Roads

The Council of The Regional Municipality of York HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Despite any by-law establishing speed limits on Regional Roads, the speed limit on that section of highway set out in Column 1 of Schedule "A" to this by-law, during the period of time set out in Column 2 of the said Schedule, shall be the speed set out opposite thereto in Column 3 of the said Schedule.
2. Schedule "A", hereto attached, shall form part of this by-law.
