The letter stated that the Application has been granted, but is limited to municipal residential waste only and that commingling with unapproved waste such as industrial, commercial, and institutional waste or municipal residential waste from an unapproved jurisdiction is not approved. **Received and referred to Staff for report to the October 21, 2004 Regional Council meeting.**
