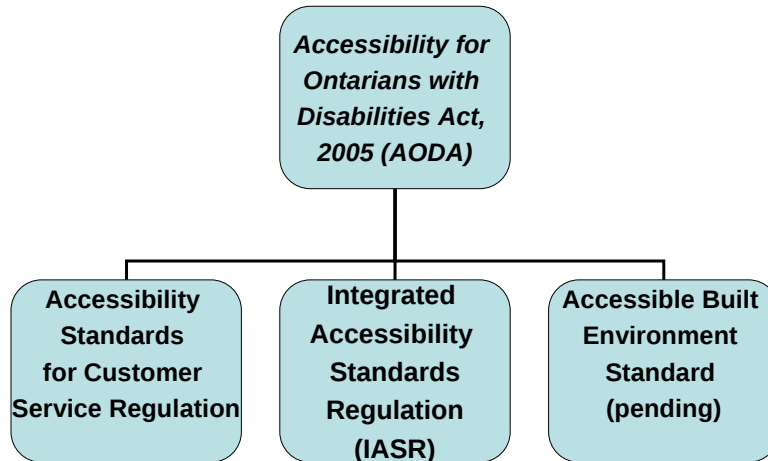

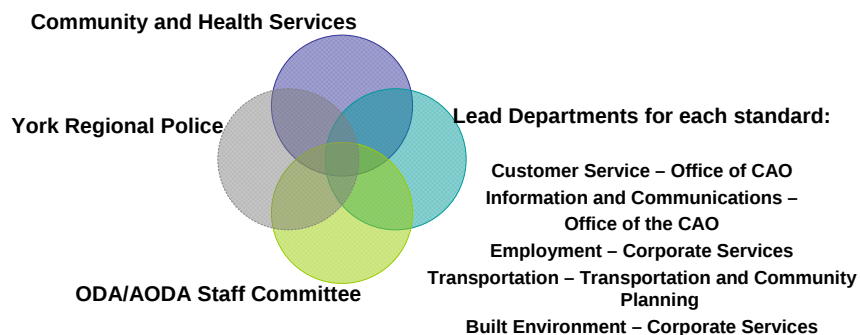

Summary of Integrated Accessibility Standards Regulation

- Effective July 1, 2011
- Five sections:
 - - General
 - - Information and Communications Standard
 - - Employment Standard
 - - Transportation Standard
 - - Compliance
- Applies to the public, private and not-for-profit sectors in Ontario

Sections 21 – 32 (excluding 27)

Recruitment, assessment, notice,
supports, accommodation plans,
return to work process, performance
management, career development
and advancement, redeployment



Transportation - July 1, 2011

Fares, storage of mobility aids,
announcements, grab bars, floors,
mobility aid spaces, lighting, signage,
lifting devices, steps,
indicators/alarms

Origin to destination services
(specialized)
