SITE PLAN APPROVALS

The Transportation and Works Committee recommends the adoption of the recommendation contained in the following report, March 24, 2006, from the Commissioner of Transportation and Works:

1. RECOMMENDATION

1. It is recommended that this report be received for information.

2. PURPOSE

This report is intended to provide information to Committee and Regional Council with respect to site plan applications processed in the second half of 2005.

3. BACKGROUND

At its meeting of November 23, 1995, Regional Council authorized the Commissioner of Transportation and Works to approve the conditions of site plan approval and execute site plan agreements on behalf of the Regional Corporation. At that meeting, the Commissioner was directed to report, on a regular basis, on recently approved site plans.

4. ANALYSIS AND OPTIONS

During the period from July 1, 2005 to December 31, 2005, the Region approved 55 site plan applications, four more applications than the same period a year earlier.

The following is a breakdown of the approvals by municipality:
