BY-LAW NO. S-0001(e)-2006-030

To amend By-Law No. S-1-70-19

WHEREAS Regional Council, by its enactment of By-Law No. S-1-70-19, assumed as part of the regional sewage works the Newmarket/East Gwillimbury Water Pollution Control Plant situated on the Holland River in the Town of Newmarket; and

WHEREAS the said by-law inadvertently misdescribed the lands on which the Newmarket/East Gwillimbury Water Pollution Control Plant was located, however, pursuant to the Municipal Water and Sewage Transfer Act, the Ontario Clean Water Agency, subsequently transferred the correct lands to the Regional Corporation by Transfer Order; and

WHEREAS the lands on which the Newmarket/East Gwillimbury Water Pollution Control Plant was situated is now being used for the Newmarket Pumping Station and the Water and Wastewater Bayview Operations Centre;

WHEREAS Regional Council, at its meeting held on October 16, 2003 by its adoption of Report 8(8) of the Finance and Administration Committee declared part of the above site as surplus and authorized the transfer of these lands to The Corporation of the Town of Newmarket in exchange for other lands; and

WHEREAS the land exchange with The Corporation of the Town of Newmarket has now been completed and it is therefore appropriate that the Newmarket/East Gwillimbury Water Pollution Control Plant be deleted from By-law No. S-1-70-19.

Now, therefore, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York HEREBY
ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule “A” to By-law No. S-1-70-19, being a by-law to assume as part of the regional sewage works certain sewage treatment works therein designated and described, as amended, is further amended by deleting therefrom section III, being the Newmarket/East Gwillimbury Water Pollution Control Plant.
