BY-LAW NO. S-0067-2006-105

A by-law to assume certain trunk sewers
in the City of Vaughan and the Town of Aurora

WHEREAS Regional Council at its meeting held on September 9, 1999, by its adoption of Report 13(1) of the Transportation and Works Committee, authorized the assumption of certain works from The Corporation of the City of Vaughan and The Corporation of the Town of Aurora, subject to certain conditions;

AND WHEREAS the said conditions have been fulfilled and the assumption of the infrastructure may now proceed;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

1. that the West Rainbow Trunk Sewer, from Highway 27 easterly along lands between Highway 7 and Highway 407 to the Islington Avenue Trunk Sewer, located southwest of the intersection of Highway 407 and Islington Avenue (Y.R. 17), in the City of Vaughan, is hereby assumed by The Regional Municipality of York;
2. that the Islington Avenue Trunk Sewer, located on Islington Avenue (Y.R. 17) from approximately 200 metres south of Highway 7 to Willis Road, in the City of Vaughan, is hereby assumed by The Regional Municipality of York; and
3. that the East Holland Trunk Sewer, located along St. John's Sideroad from the Aurora Pumping Station to the tributary of the East Holland River, between Bayview Avenue and Leslie Street, and then on the tableland from St. John's Sideroad to Wellington Street, in the Town of Aurora, is hereby assumed by The Regional Municipality of York;
